Next week 11th-15th February is Book Week in our school.

We have organised a wide variety of activities to promote books and reading throughout the week. Please see below for a resume of some of the activities the children will engage in.

- ❖ The very popular D.E.A.R. event (Drop Everything And Read) will take place each day - teachers will pay surprise visits to classes and will read or tell stories and recite poetry to the children: be sure to ask your child all about it.
- ❖ Junior Infants will create and design bookmarks.
- ❖ Senior Infants will redesign the cover of their favourite book.
- ❖ Children from First Class will dress up as a character from their favourite book on **Friday**.
- ❖ We will have our Floor Quiz for our Second classes on **Thursday**. Why have a Table Quiz when we can have a floor quiz instead?
- ❖ The children in First and in Second Class are going to visit the Junior Infant classes and read stories to them.
- ❖ On **Wednesday** we will hold our Annual Book Fair.



BOOK FAIR 2019

Our annual Book Fair will be held on Wednesday 13th February in the school hall. You are invited to come along either during school hours or at night. The Fair will be open at the following times on Wednesday only:

- 9 a.m.- 2.30p.m. during school hours
- 6.30 p.m.- 7.30p.m. at night.

The catalogue your child will receive shows some of books which are available for children of all reading abilities.

If you are unable to visit the school on that day there is another way in which you can purchase books for your child:

You can look through the selection of books in the Book Fair Catalogue and make your choice. Then put the exact money in an envelope and you give it to the class teacher.

On the envelope please state:

1. Name of child
2. Name of class teacher
3. Book required
4. Amount enclosed (Cash only).

Our school will receive 60% commission on all sales which will be used by the teachers to buy new books for the main school library and for the class libraries.
