APPENDIX 4: MAKING AN APPLICATION

Below are the guidelines parents/guardians must consider when making an application for a place in St. Attractas JNS:

- Applications for places can only be made and accepted from during the period set out in the <u>Annual Admissions Notice</u>. The Annual Admissions Notice will be published at least one week before the school starts to accept applications. It will be communicated to prospective applicants through:
 - the school's website <u>www.stattractasjns.ie</u>
 - e mailed to all current families in St Attractas Junior and Senior Schools on the date of its publication
 - Notice via text message to contact numbers provided by parents/guardians of children who are already enrolled in the school
 - o notices on external school doors/newsletters home
- All Children seeking a place in Junior Infants must satisfy the age requirement as stated in this Annual Admissions Notice i.e. they must have reached the age of 4 on or before 31st March in the year they are due to start school.
- Junior Infants are only admitted to the school on the first day of the academic school year in which they are starting school.
- The only exceptions to this rule is if Junior Infant places remain unfilled up to and including the 30th of September of the year of enrolment, or if the child is already enrolled in a Junior Infant Class in another school and is transferring to Junior Infants in St. Attractas Junior School mid-year.

Submitting an Application form

All Parents/Guardians must ensure that they do all of the following when submitting an Application Form:

- 1. Complete an Application Form for *St Attractas JNS,* and return it to the school in the period specified in the Annual Admissions Notice
- 2. Complete both sides of the Application Form
- 3. Application must be signed by **both** parents/guardians where joint custody applies
- 4. Attach a copy of the original Birth/Adoption Certificate (school reserves the right to view the original document prior to enrolment)
- Applications from all new families living within the geographical boundaries of the Parish of Meadowbrook require proof of address as follows:
 - Two (2) different utility bills in the name of the parent who has signed the Application Form, with both first name and surname must accompany the application.
 - The bills must be dated within the previous 3 months of the date of submission by the parent/guardian on the Application Form. (See Appendix 1 - Meadowbrook Parish Roads List and Appendix 2 - List of acceptable utility bills that must accompany each application)
- 6. Where the applicant cannot present the stipulated utility bills, a letter from a Peace Commissioner / Commissioner of Oaths, confirming that the address given is the primary residence of the child/applicant. This letter must be dated within the previous 3 months of the date of submission form by the parent/guardian of the application form.
- 7. Enclose a stamped envelope, addressed to you the parent/guardian to allow the school to acknowledge receipt of the Application and to return original certificates as applicable
- 8. Submit all of the above to the school in an envelope addressed as follows:
